



This classic home in Seattle's Magnolia neighborhood features an elegant veranda which wraps around three sides of the house, and provided stunning views of the Puget Sound shipping lanes and Olympic Mountains.

Through the years however, weather and exposure had taken their toll on the main supports holding the veranda in place, and they had to be replaced. Bella Construction removed all 36 of the existing supports, and replaced them with 18 new supports, each constructed of glue-lam beams, then clad in a decorative exterior, forming a column which blends perfectly with the exterior of the home. The result is both elegant and functional, and best of all, reveals even more of the stunning views.
